On a tournament roll, Brian placed 2nd at Santa Clara's college tournament at Silver Creek Valley G.C. Brian's collegiate scholarship doubled his sophomore year and he earned the team's MVP award.

In 2007, Brian graduated from Sacramento State with a BA degree in Art Studio and in 2008 started working for Ancil Hoffman Golf Course as an Assistant Pro.

Will Robins Golf welcomed Brian to the team in 2011. Brian was Head Coach of the WRGolf location in Lincoln at Turkey Creek G.C. and in Elverta at Cherry Island G.C.
